Dental services include cleanings, dental exams, dentures, extractions, fillings, oral hygiene instruction, restorative care, root canals, sealants, and x-rays. Services are provided on a sliding discount based on income and family size. A minimum payment is required at the time services are provided. Medical Assistance is accepted.
